Dear Ms. Dunlop,

I read the February 2, Washington Post article concerning the decision of the Ozone Transport Commission. I wonder, when reading articles of this type, if any of the people on these panels has bothered to research the facts before making decisions. For example, the President of General Motors, more than 64 years ago predicted automobile fuel economy of 80 MPG. Yet, that technology, and the technology that Shell Oil Company used to achieve more than 376 MPG 21 years ago, has not been implemented many, I know of 15, patents exist for devices that allow an engine to burn water, we don't even need gasoline. The proven hydrogen fuel technology has not been implemented. Yet, a hydrogen fueled Cadillac was in President Carter inaugural parade. Somewhere in my files, I have a photograph of Dr. Billings, who designed the hydrogen fuel system for that Cadillac, drinking the exhaust from a hydrogen fueled engine. There are too many other examples of proven energy technology that can solve the environmental problems, that we have created, to list here.
